Classs Dojo is an on-line rewards and messaging system which can be accessed from all smart phones, tablets, i-pads etc, meaning that when your child is rewarded you will instantly get a notification. It also allows the school to connect with parents/carers much easier and quicker when sending out information and quick messages. The teachers at Trevisker have had a good look at its capabilities and are delighted that it will allow them to show off your childrens learning and add photographs directly when learning is taking place anytime, any place, anywhere. We will be sending out further information for you to link up with the schools account so please look out for this in the book bag post or via emails next week. The children are very excited about this new system ad have had their first taster of being awarded dojos today.

## Next weeks Trevisker Times to look forward to ......

Reception—Acorn Class - will be enjoying their topic' Marvellous Me ' and learning about different families and how to look after themselves.

Year 1— Birch Class - will be starting their topic all about farms and will be learning about the history of farming.

Year 2—Willow class - Their topic for this term is 'Enchanted Forests', so the children will be focusing on all things plants and trees and exploring what makes a plant thrive.
